- School Improvement Plan Review

- Trustlands Funding Reports
 - Academic Mentor
 - Shelly Thorne, SJH's academic mentor, shared with the council the success the school has had with having an academic mentor. She shared data on student success as well. Duties she performs: attends local case management, she's a level 2 & 3 intervention, currently has 24 students (but this fluctuates throughout the year), helps students with organization, homework help, accountability and getting things done. Shelly also has a close relationship with students' teachers to help with their success. She's a "mom" to many children.
 - Projector Refresh
 - Syracuse Jr High received 1/3 of the new projectors during this current school year. Another third will be put into classrooms during 2018-2019 school year, and the project will be completed and all classrooms will have their projectors replaced by the 2019-2020 school year. Teachers that have had theirs replaced are very happy with the improvement. They are benefiting the classrooms.
 - o Art Printer and Professional Development
 - The \$300.00 given last year was for training on how to teach a student to throw clay on a wheel was not used because the art teachers do not have enough wheels to add this teaching into their curriculum. The money is still in the account and can now be used for other things.
